9990 AleSmith Ct (5 minutes from San Diego VR)

Home to the legendary Speedway Stout, AleSmith is arguably San Diego's most acclaimed brewery. This massive facility features multiple tasting rooms, including a hidden barrel-aged speakeasy and the Tony Gwynn Hall of Fame. Their \$10 brewery tour includes a commemorative glass and showcases why they're considered one of the country's top breweries. The expansive outdoor patio regularly hosts food trucks, making it perfect for extended visits.

Mission Brewing - Miramar

3869 Miramar St (3 minutes from San Diego VR)

Taking over the former Rough Draft location, Mission Brewing's Miramar facility offers a shiny, clean space with both indoor and outdoor seating plus a sizable production facility. Known for their innovative 12% tripel and wildly creative 12% seltzers, Mission provides a modern brewery experience in the heart of Beeramar.

Pure Project - Miramar

9030 Kenamar Dr (4 minutes from San Diego VR)

Pure Project's Miramar location serves as a satellite taproom and Brewery Igniter facility, offering their full range of experimental and core beers. Known for pushing boundaries in brewing, Pure Project attracts serious craft beer enthusiasts looking for unique flavors and innovative brewing techniques.

Protector Brewery

8680 Miralani Dr, Suite 128 (2 minutes from San Diego VR)

Specializing in unfiltered, organic, vegan beer with mindful brewing practices, Protector Brewery offers a unique approach to craft brewing. Their commitment to sustainable and ethical brewing practices appeals to environmentally conscious beer lovers while maintaining exceptional quality and flavor.

Ballast Point Brewing - Miramar

9045 Carroll Way (8 minutes from San Diego VR)

The headquarters and main brewing campus of one of San Diego's most famous breweries, home to the iconic Sculpin IPA. This impressive operation offers 45-minute tours with commemorative glasses for \$5, elegant dining areas, and spacious patio seating. Despite being acquired and returned to craft ownership, Ballast Point continues producing excellent San Diego beer.

Mike Hess Brewing - Miramar

7955 Silverton Avenue (6 minutes from San Diego VR)

While Mike Hess's North Park location gets more attention, their original Miramar tasting room remains a solid stop for beer crawls. Known for producing some of San Diego's favorite beers, Mike Hess offers quality brews in a more intimate setting compared to their newer facilities.

Duck Foot Brewing

8920 Kenamar Dr (5 minutes from San Diego VR)

Located in the same complex as Pure Project, Duck Foot Brewing offers easy brewery hopping. Their Miramar location provides a different atmosphere from their East Village spot, focusing on the authentic brewery experience in the industrial heart of Beeramar.

Gravity Heights - Sorrento Valley

11545 Sorrento Valley Rd (12 minutes from San Diego VR)

While technically in Sorrento Valley, Gravity Heights is close enough to include in North County brewery tours. Their elevated location offers great views along with excellent craft beer and food options.
